### ***Billy Graham Center Museum***

A museum displaying a unique visual overview of the history of Christian Evangelism.

### ***Illinois Holocaust Museum & Education Center***

A gripping memorial created by local holocaust survivors, their families and those seeking to understand the history of the events to took place.

### ***KAM Isaiah Israel***

Founded in 1847 as Kehilath Anshe Ma'arav, this synagogue is in the Kenwood neighborhood of Chicago, known for its large homes and well-to-do residents, such as Barack Obama and Muhammad Ali.

### ***Baker Memorial United Methodist Church***

Historic church building dating back to 1878.



### ***BAPS Shri Swaminaraya Mandir***

The fusion of traditional Indian architecture with modern technology.

### ***Willow Creek Community Church***

This church has been listed as the most influential church in America for the last several years.

### ***Nuova Italia***

Built in 1851, a bit of history exists here in a church turned restaurant.

### ***Lao Buddhist Temple of Elgin***

Founded in 2011 by Laotian settlers to the US , this temple practices Theravada Buddhism.
